**Subject:** HB 2845 – Relating to statewide social studies standards

**Work Session Recommendations** 

HB 2845-A requires the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to convene a 13-member advisory group to review the current standards for social sciences and identify opportunities to recognize histories, contributions, and perspectives of ethnic and social minorities. The measure has a \$43,149 General Fund impact and one position (0.25 FTE) in the 2017-19 biennium.

## **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A5 amendment which appropriates \$43,149 General Fund the Department of Education and sunsets the bill on January 2, 2022.
