**Subject:** HB 2238 – Relating to crime  
Work Session Recommendation

House Bill 2238 establishes a thirteen-member Task Force on Public Safety and directs it to study security release, the impact of criminal fines and fees, and the implementation of the Justice Reinvestment program. Additionally, the measure directs the Criminal Justice Commission to prepare racial and ethnic impact statements on legislation and ballot measures related to crime, and transfers the obligation to produce racial and ethnic impact statements on legislation and ballot measures related to human services to the Department of Human Services pending a January 2nd, 2018 repeal.

The original staff measure summary and the fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure previously had hearings in the House Judiciary Committee on 4/4/2017 and 4/14/2017.

The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact on the Judicial Department, the Department of Corrections, cities and counties, and the Criminal Justice Commission. The fiscal impact to the Secretary of State is indeterminate, and there is no fiscal impact to the Department of Administrative Services, District Attorneys, or the Public Defenders.
