To the Joint Committee on Transportation Preservation and Modernization

Dear Senator Beyer and Representative McKeown,

We strongly support your work developing a comprehensive transportation package. Increased investment in our infrastructure is critical to both a thriving economy and our region's ability to accommodate our population growth.

We also strongly support a significant investment in our public transit system as part of this package. As legislators from the Portland Metropolitan area, we know how critical robust TriMet service is to our region – as well as the accessibility of the service.

Funding transit has always been challenging. We understand that currently there is a maximum .8% payroll tax on employers being phased in, which funds more 60% of TriMet's operations. We also understand that one of the proposed revenue sources for the current legislative proposal is a .1% payroll tax on employees for transit.

While .1% may seem small, this is the first time that we will be creating an employee-side payroll tax to fund transit and there <u>will</u> be an impact on low-income wage earners. Therefore, we strongly recommend the committee secure a commitment from TriMet that, if an employee-side payroll tax is implemented as part of the package, the agency will use a portion of the funds to implement a low-income fare.

We need to make TriMet more accessible to low-income residents, and this funding stream makes sense as a way of making a low-income fare a reality. We understand that TriMet and its partners are currently developing the framework for such a program, and, as you develop the transit proposal, we feel it is important to include this in the conversation.

Thank you for your consideration and all your hard work.
