

SB 693 A -A3, -A4 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Senate Bill 693 eliminates probationary driver permits, makes changes to the requirements to obtain a hardship permit, and repeals driver license suspensions for several criminal offenses.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Fiscal impact of the measure
- Proposed amendments

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-A3 The -A3 amendment restores the Department of Revenue's ability to suspend or revoke a driver license or permit for failure to pay taxes. This amendment does not change the fiscal impact.

-A4 The -A4 amendment expands the current exemption for members of the Armed Forces and their spouses from holding an Oregon driver license to include National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and their spouses. This amendment does not change the fiscal impact.
