Subject: HB 3398 - Relating to state financial administration Work Session Recommendations

The -1 amendment replaces the original bill. In current law, the Oregon Medical Insurance Pool Account is abolished effective July 1, 2017. The amendment will extend that date to November 1, 2017, at which point any remaining balances will be refunded to insurers. It also continuously appropriates the moneys in the fund to the Department of Consumer and Business Services, rather than the Oregon Medical Insurance Pool Board.

It is estimated that about $\$ 50$ million will remain in the fund after all claims are paid. This money is expected to be used in the new reinsurance program that will be a part of HB 2391. By extending the date that the fund ends, these resources will remain in the fund, available to be used in the reinsurance program if HB 2391 becomes law.
