**Re:** SB 360 Relating to prisoner reentry

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**Senator Frederick:** "SB 360 directs each county to establish a community service exchange program for individuals to perform community service in lieu of payment of delinquent fees for debts or fees for supervision. Currently, offenders on parole or post-prison supervision are required to pay a fixed fee to counties that is intended to cover the costs of supervision, but those fees can be reduced or modified by the county.

The measure is anticipated to have an indeterminate impact to counties and their community corrections programs. Both revenue and expenditures for each county exchange program will depend on the number of offenders that are eligible and the length of time they participate in the program.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 360 be reported out do pass."
