Dear Members of the Senate Education Committee,

I am writing in opposition to allowing SB 437 to proceed any further towards being passed into law. This is nothing more than a back door voucher program that will take desperately needed funds away from our public school systems and hand it to entities, including religious schools and home school families, which would in no way be accountable to the taxpayers who would be funding them.

Here is what Save Our School Arizona, candidate for AZ state senate Radeem Robinson, and friends from Arizona (where two of my sisters live) had to say when I asked them about the ESA plan in Arizona.
