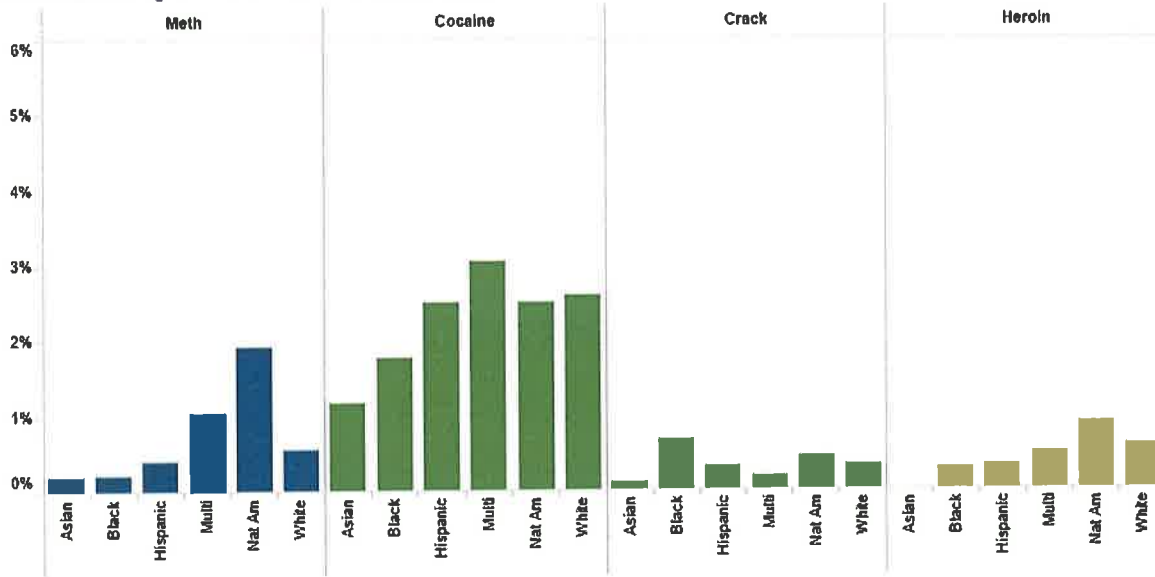


National Drug Usage Data

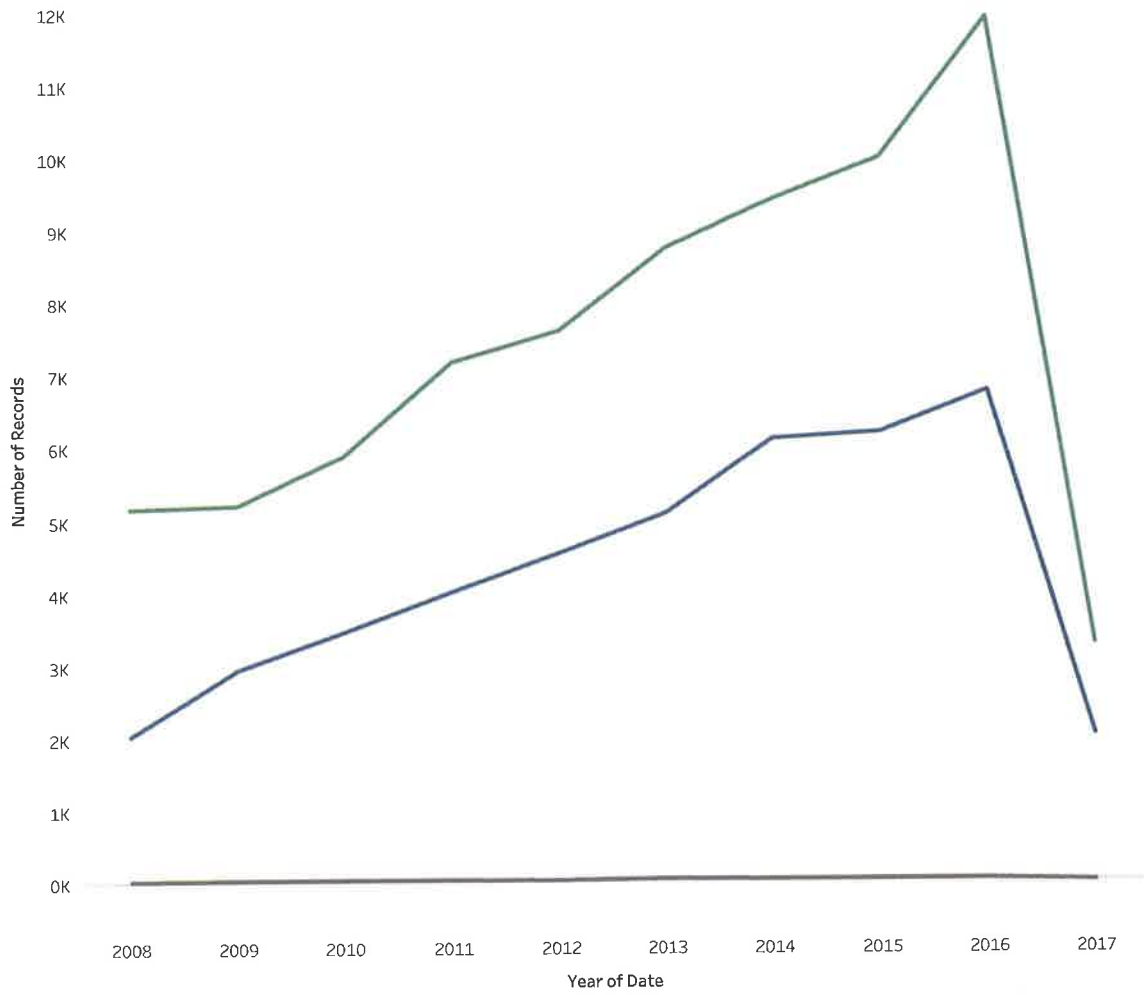
Age All

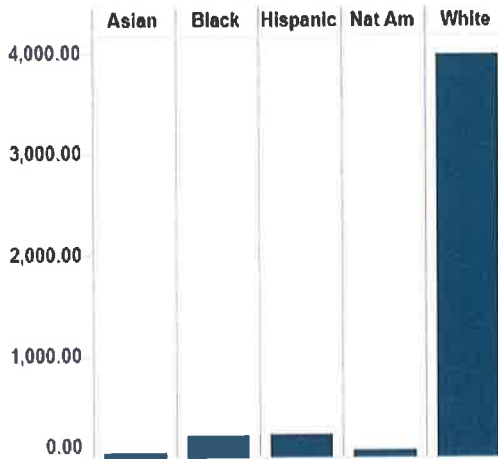

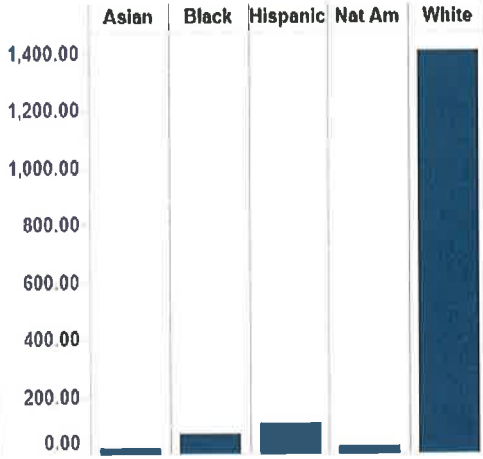

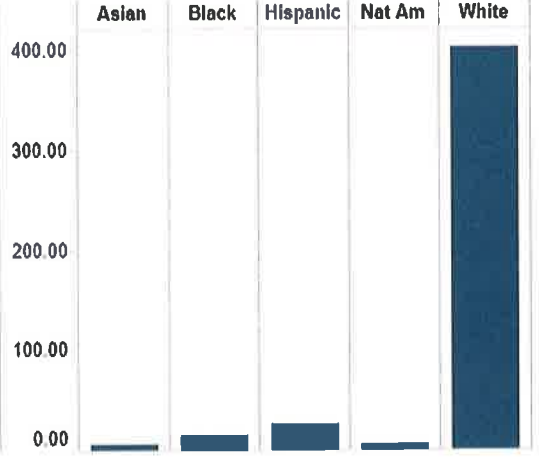

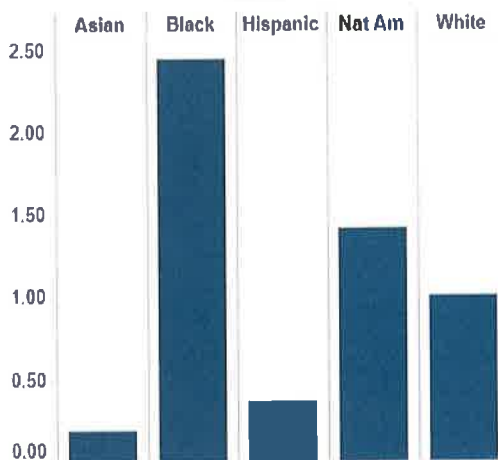

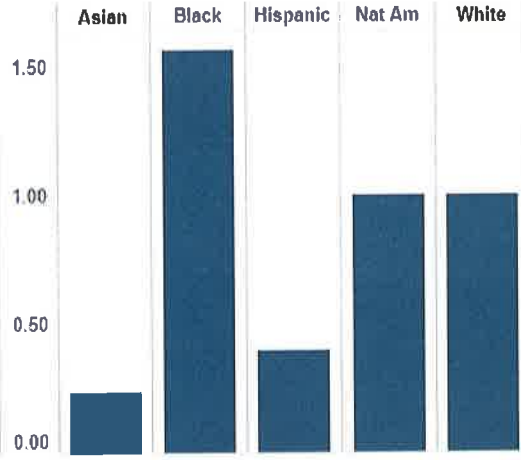

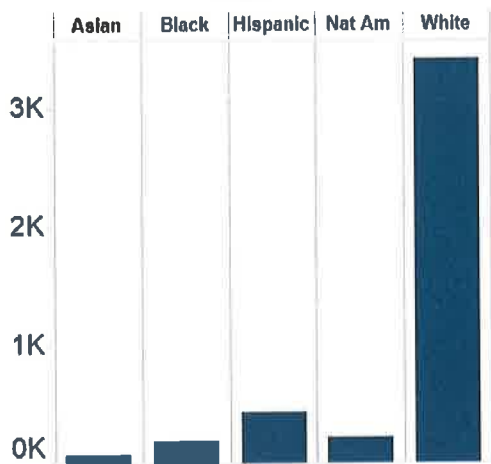

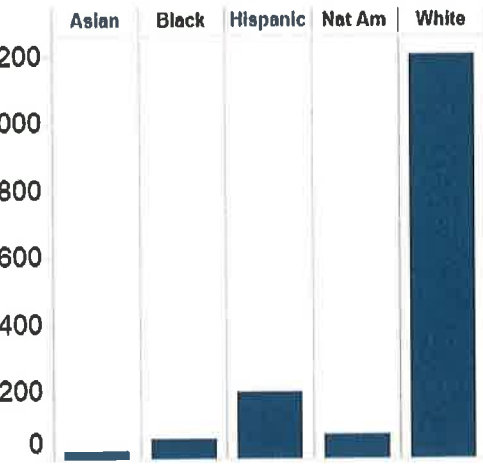

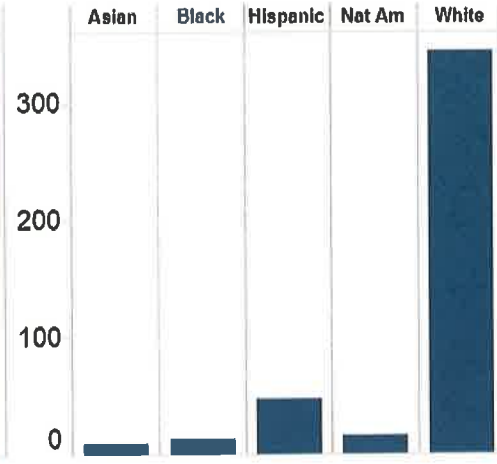

Estimated Self-Reported Felony Convictions by Ratio to White

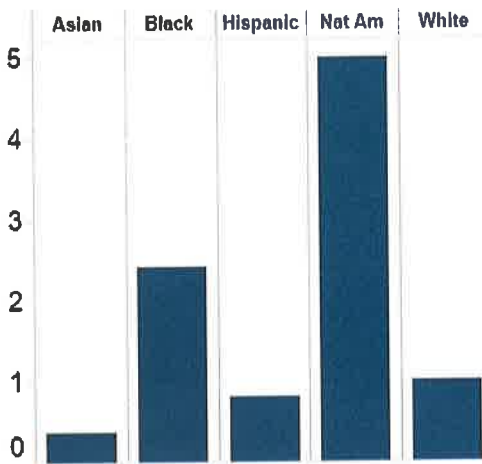

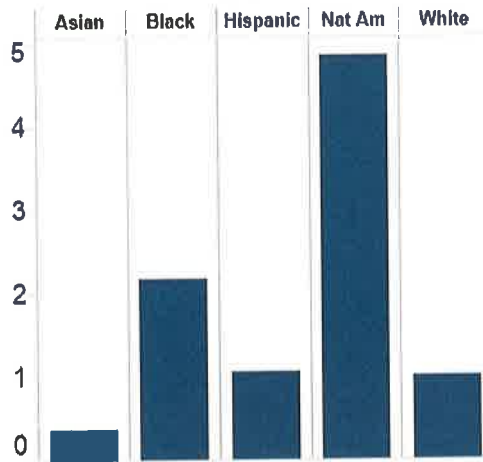
