Subject: SB 200 - Relating to retirement credit for periods of service in

uniformed services

Senate Bill 200 relates to retirement credit for periods of service in uniformed services. The measure is a narrowly defined revision to Public Employees Retirement System statute. The measure has an emergency clause and is effective on passage. The Senate Committee on Workforce held a public hearing (3/6) and a work session on the measure (4/5). The measure passed from Senate Workforce to Ways and Means with a "Do pass" recommendation. A preliminary staff measure summary, fiscal impact, and revenue impact are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure has a minimal expenditure impact and no revenue impact.

There is no amendment to the measure.
