Subject: SB 712 – Relating to credit for periods of disability under the Oregon

Public Service Retirement Plan

Senate Bill 712 relates to credit for periods of disability under the Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan. The measure is a narrowly defined revision to Public Employees Retirement System statute. The measure has an emergency clause and is effective on passage. The Senate Committee on Workforce held a public hearing (3/20) and a work session on the measure (4/5). The measure passed from Senate Workforce to Ways and Means with a "Do pass" recommendation. A preliminary staff measure summary, fiscal impact, and revenue impact are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure has a minimal expenditure impact and no revenue impact.
