I support HB2927 and do not support SB825. It's time now for the Oregon legislature to join 11 other states and pass the National Popular Vote bill!

I support electing our president according to the national popular vote. I am satisfied with the election of our governor, U.S. Senators, U.S. House members and indeed every other office according to the principle of one-person, one-vote.

To be clear, I recognize that my favorite candidate will sometimes lose in a popular vote election. I also am aware that the winner of Oregon's vote may not win the presidency.
