

Dear Members of the Senate Rules Committee,

I am writing to you today to urge you and the Oregon legislature at large to pass HB 2927 as it is and not pass SB 825. The President of the United States should be representative of all citizens and it is time we adopt the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact so that each vote counts equally. My vote is just as important as that of an individual in any other state.

The constitution grants state legislatures the responsibility of determining how our electors vote in the electoral college. It is in all of your hands to have Oregon set an example encouraging a national popular voting system. Please do not support SB 825, which abdicates this constitutional responsibility of the legislature in favor of referring the issue to the voters.
