

As an Oregonian I strongly urge the Oregon legislature to pass HB2927 as is out of committee and not pass SB 825. The President should be representative of all people of the United States and it is time we adopt the National Popular Vote Interstate Compact so one person = one vote. My vote should count equally as any other voting individual in any other state.

The constitution grants state legislatures the responsibility of determining how our electors vote in the electoral college.
