**Subject:** SB 314 – Relating to Relief Nursery programs  
Work Session Recommendations

SB 314 directs the Oregon Department of Education, Early Learning Division (ELD), to support Relief Nursery programs and provides specific examples of qualifying costs for which funding may support. The bill defines a Relief Nursery program and requires programs to report child participation and progress to a database created and maintained by the Oregon Association of Relief Nurseries. The bill excludes state asset forfeiture proceeds from the calculation of minimum community matching funds required for Relief Nursery programs.

**Recommended Changes**

Adoption of the -A4 amendment is recommended.
