Subject: SB 512 – Relating to parentage Work Session Recommendations

SB 512 establishes parentage based on the presumption that the spouse of a birth mother is a parent to her child. This extends the current marital presumption to include same-sex spouses of birth mothers, providing a basis for parentage for purposes of child support. The bill also clarifies parentage related to children born as the result of assisted reproduction. Finally, the bill updates paternity/parentage language to be gender neutral.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, and the fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Judiciary on 4/10/17 and 4/18/17. The Human Services Subcommittee of Ways and Means held a public hearing on 6/12/17.

The -A4 amendment adds \$52,812 General Fund for the Oregon Health Authority for the cost of modifying data systems.
