

I am asking the Oregon legislature to **pass HB2927 as is** and **not pass SB 825**. The US President should be a representative of all people of the United States and therefore we need to use a National Popular Vote Interstate Compact so one person = one vote. My vote should count equally as any other voting individual in any other state.

The constitution grants state legislatures the responsibility of determining how our electors vote in the electoral college. I urge you to **not** support SB 825 which pushes the issue to voters like me. This decision belongs to the legislature just as when Oregon first adopted the winner-take-all system that we have today.

Please pass HB 2927 out of committee and do not pass SB 825.
