**Subject:** SB 689 – Relating to the Task Force on Reentry, Employment, and Housing  
Work Session Recommendation

Senate Bill 689 recreates the 20-member Task Force on Reentry, Employment, and Housing to allow it to continue studying and recommending methods and actions that state and local governments can take to help with reentry into the community for people leaving incarceration, to expand employment and housing opportunities for people with criminal convictions, and to create certifications for people with criminal convictions. The measure requires the task force to submit a report to the Legislature by September 15th, 2018, and the task force would sunset on December 31, 2018.

The original staff measure summary and the fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Judiciary Committee on 3/14/2017 and 4/6/2017, and in the Public Safety subcommittee on June 12th.

The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact on the agencies and counties that participate as members on the task force, and on the Legislative Assembly and the legislative staff offices supporting the task force.
