Let's have Oregon be part of the interstate pact to have the Electoral College choose the President according to the popular vote, and let's do it tomorrow, without referral to the voters. The Constitution gives state legislators the freedom to choose how to give their votes, and I'm asking you to choose HB2927 and NOT SB825. If opponents object to the bill after it's passed, there's a referendum process in place to deal with that. My vote should count, should be equal to that of any other voter in any other state. Oregon voters don't count as much as voters in Wyoming. Let's fix that.
