HB 2007 does not provide for consideration of Comp Plans, neighborhood context, and city infrastructure needs. Our neighborhoods are already losing their much valued history and livability. Buildings that are out of character and way over-sized are already ruining our neighborhoods...and this bill is sure to encourage more of this. Please protect the character and livability of our neighborhoods.

I believe HB 2007 was created by people who will financially benefit from unregulated development...and little regard has been given to how the development will impact the rest of us. Please scrap this bill...or at the very least improve it immensely to protect our already existing affordable housing, historical buildings and the livability of our neighborhoods.
