Subject:HB 2605 – Relating to the establishment of circuit court judge positionsWork Session Recommendations

HB 2605 establishes new circuit court judge positions. HB 2605 was reported out of the House Committee on Judiciary on February 15, and referred to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means by prior reference.

The new judgeships established by the bill become operative in January 2019, following the 2018 General Election. The bill includes a blank General Fund appropriation to the Oregon Judicial Department for costs associated with new judges, support staff, and associated equipment and supplies costs.

Recommended Changes

The Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) recommends adoption of the -1 amendments. These amendments modify the bill to establish one additional circuit court judge for Washington County and one additional circuit court judge for Josephine County. The Chief Justice identified these as the two judicial districts in the state with the highest need for additional judges based on workloads. The amendments also appropriate \$617,468 General Fund to the Judicial Department, for the 2017-19 biennium costs associated with establishing the new judgeships.

The new judges will assume the duties of office on January 7, 2019. Support staff positions are established on November 1, 2018.
