**Subject:** HB 2260-A – Relating to  
Work Session Recommendations

Major features of this bill include:

- Directs Office of Child Care (OCC) to maintain a website on certified and registered child care facilities and regulated subsidy facilities.
- Authorizes OCC to maintain information about child care facilities and providers through electronic records system.
- Permits OCC to share information on investigations or inspections with other public entities when it supports the health or safety of children.
- Clarifies complaints, not limited to serious complaints, may be received and investigated by OCC.
- Prohibits disclosing identifying information about an individual or entity that made the complaint.

There is a minimal fiscal impact of this bill and any costs will be covered by the ODE budget.

### **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment.
