Subject: SB 942 – Relating to child safety

Work Session Recommendations

SB 942 relates to actions and findings the Department of Human Services (DHS) must take and make when investigating child abuse.

The amendment, preliminary staff measure summary, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Human Services on 3/27/17 and 4/10/17.

The -A3 amendment removes the requirement that Department of Human Services conduct exit interviews within 14 days of removing a child in substitute care from a placement. This changes the fiscal to minimal.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment.
