Subject: SB 867 – Relating to maritime sector workforce development

SB 867 establishes the 17-member Task Force on Maritime Sector Workforce Development. The task force is charged with studying and developing a description of the scope and extent of the maritime sector and its workforce in Oregon and make recommendations to the State Workforce Investment Board. The task force must report to the State Workforce Investment Board and the legislature by September 15, 2018. The Association of Oregon Counties is directed to provide staff support to the task force. Members of the task force who are not members of the Legislative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force. The task force sunsets on December 31, 2018. The bill has a minimal fiscal impact in the 2017-19 biennium.
