Measure Description:

Exempts from property taxation real and personal property, including inventory, of retail store owned by nonprofit corporation if retail store deals exclusively in donated inventory, individuals who operate retail store, other than manager and bookkeeper, work as volunteers and all net proceeds of retail store sales are donated to animal shelter, to entity that provides spaying and neutering services for pets of individuals in low-income households or to assist low-income households in obtaining
