Subject: SB 1041 Relating to treatment funded by public moneys
Work Session Recommendations

Senate Bill 1041 directs the Criminal Justice Commission to study, track, and account for all public moneys appropriated for and expended on alcohol and drug treatment and report on the results to the Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2019. As part of the study, CJC is to examine the treatment provided by the state, other public entities, or private entities that have contracts with public entities. CJC is to examine the outcomes of each type of treatment and its effect on the criminal justice system.

The measure has a proposed -1 amendment that appropriates \$284,344 General Fund to the Criminal Justice Commission for a full-time limited duration policy analyst positions (1.00 FTE). The position would develop a system to track alcohol and drug treatment funds and identify treatment outcomes. The position would continue for the first three months of the 2019-21 biennium until the report is finalized.

Recommended Changes

The -1 amendment includes \$284,344 General Fund to CJC.

LFO recommends adoption of the -1 amendment.

MOTION: I move adoption of the -1 amendment to SB 1041. (VOTE)

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that SB 1041, as amended, to be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
