**Subject:** HB 3061 Relating to anonymous text message Internet websites

**Work Session Recommendations** 

House Bill 3061 creates the nine-member Task Force on Anonymous Text Message Services charged with studying changes needed in Oregon law to regulate and prohibit the use of internet websites to send anonymous abusive and harassing text messages, as well as for the delivery of controlled substances. The task force is required to report its findings and recommendations to the Legislature by September 15, 2019. The task force is effective January 1, 2018 and sunsets December 31, 2019.

The staff measure summary and the fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure had a hearing in the House Judiciary Committee on April 3rd.

The measure is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact to the Department of Justice for staffing the task force, and a minimal fiscal impact to other affected agencies.
