Subject: HB 2296 - Relating to processes affecting the physical condition of

wells

HB 2296 increases the amount of surety bond or letter of credit required to be filed with the Water Resources Commission by licensed water well constructor from \$10,000 to \$20,000.

The bill also increases the amount of surety bond or letter of credit required by nonlicensed persons constructing a water well on property that they own from \$5,000 to \$10,000, increases the permit fee for those persons from \$25 to \$500, and removes the provision requiring a permit by those persons only when constructing, altering, or converting a well by means of a well drilling machine.

The additional revenue resultant from the fee increase to non-licensed landowners is anticipated to be \$28,500 in the 2017-19 biennium and \$38,000 in the 2019-21 biennium.
