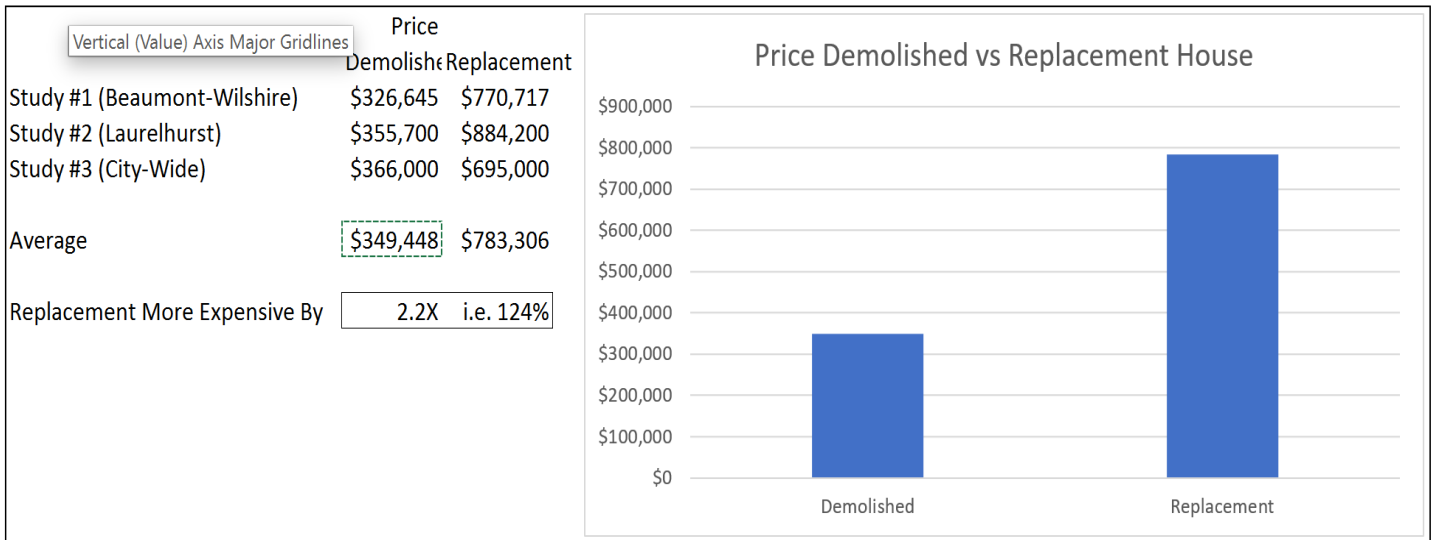

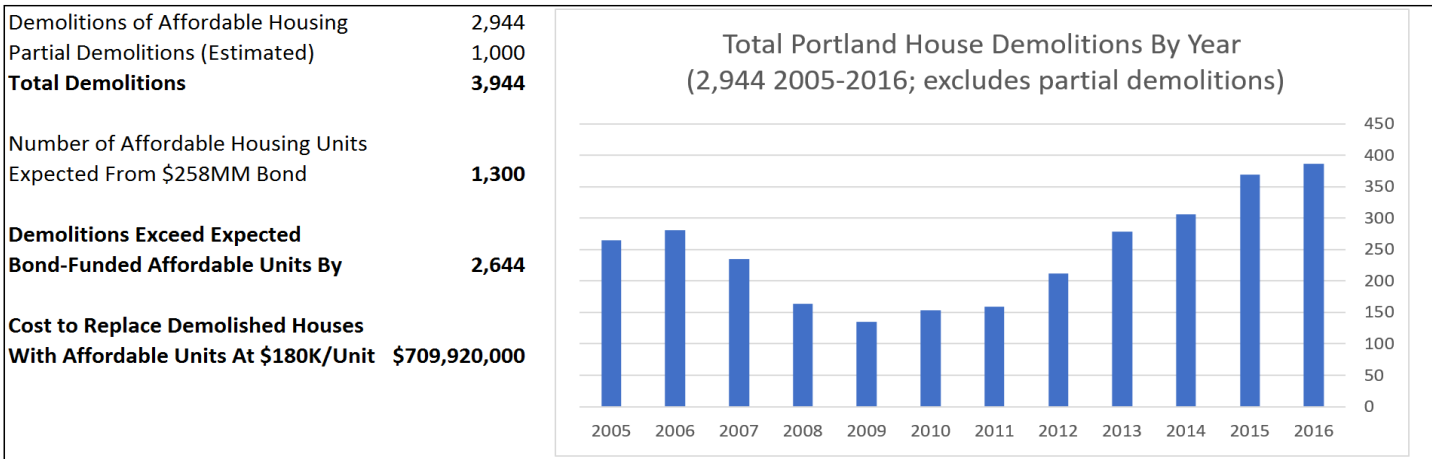

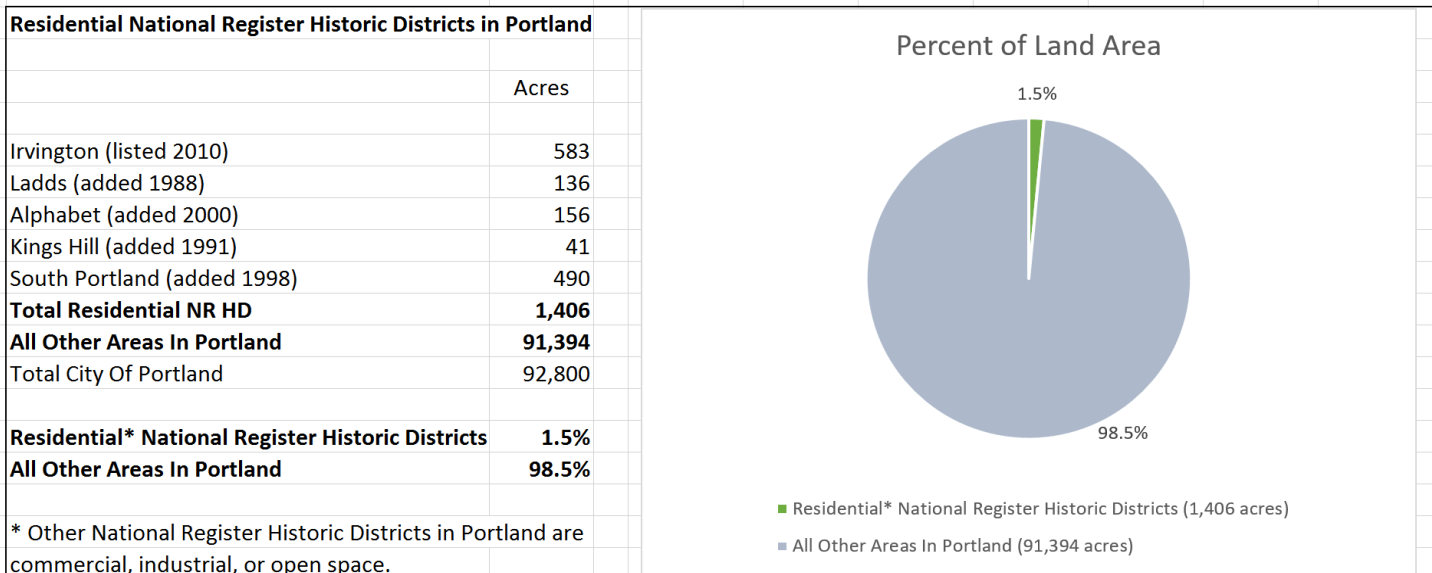
INFILL HOUSE DEMOLITIONS REPLACE AFFORDABLE HOUSING WITH EXPENSIVE HOUSING.



INFILL HOUSE DEMOLITIONS DESTROY MORE AFFORDABLE HOUSING THAN WE CAN BUILD



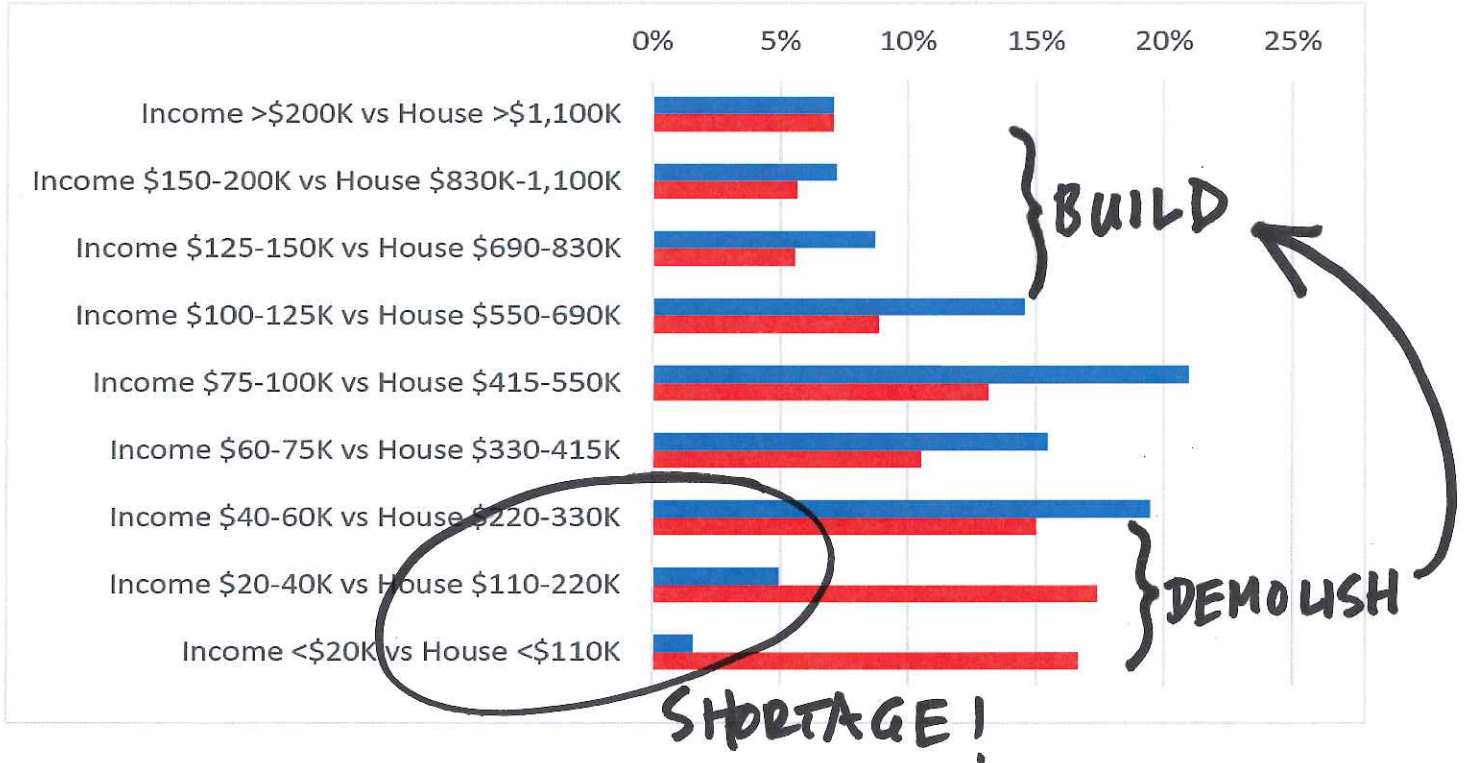
RESIDENTIAL HISTORIC DISTRICTS ARE LESS THAN 2% OF PORTLAND'S LAND
