**Subject:** HB 3276-A – Relating to health care  
Work Session Recommendations

HB 3276-A prohibits insurers from restricting coverage of health services necessary to combat disease outbreak or epidemic. In addition, the bill directs the Public Health Director to convene a task force to make recommendations for legislative changes to improve student health insurance coverage, as well as to prepare for future public health emergencies by recommending changes to public health policies relating to vaccinations. The Public Health Director must report the findings and recommendations of this task force to the Legislature by October 30, 2017.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, and the fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The measure previously had hearings in the House Committee on Health Care on 3/24/17, 3/27/17, and 4/14/17. The Human Services Subcommittee of Ways and Means held a public hearing on 6/14/17.

The cost to the Oregon Health Authority is indeterminate, but small. It will depend on the number of members, number of meetings, and scope of work undertaken.
