Subject: SB 871 – Relating to Demolitions
Work Session Recommendations

The A6 amendments replace the text of the bill. The measure as amended allows for a city to establish a program for the demolition of residences or residential buildings and sets forth a number of requirements for persons performing a demolition, including methods for dealing with lead paint for structures built before 1978. The measure also allows for the program established by a city to require the submission of an asbestos survey and notice of performance of activities related to asbestos abatement before performing the demolition.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A6 amendment.
