Subject: HB 2741 – Relating to Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account

Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 2741 appropriates General Fund in the 2017-19 to the Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD) in the Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account to assist households at 75% or less of federal poverty guidelines that suffer a loss of housing due to a wildfire. HCSD provides assistance grants in the amount of \$5,000 each to qualifying households.

A fiscal impact statement on the -1 amendment has been completed.

Recommended Changes

The -1 amendment specifies \$150,000 as the amount to be deposited in the account for this program.
