Subject: HB 2742 A – Relating to the Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account

The Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account program was established in 2015 to assist lower income households that suffer a loss of housing due to a wildfire.

HB 2742 makes changes to income limitations for receipt of financial assistance from the Wildfire Damage Housing Relief Account, from 75% of federal poverty guidelines to 200%. The bill also changes the maximum amount of the grant that may be awarded by the Housing and Community Services Department, from \$5,000 to \$7,000.

There is no fiscal impact to the Housing and Community Services Department associated with these policy changes.
