Subject: SB 558 – Relating to improving the health of Oregon children
Work Session Recommendations

SB 558 modifies eligibility requirements for the Health Care of All Oregon Children program, to make all children who reside in Oregon eligible for medical assistance, regardless of immigration status, if family income is at or below 300% of the federal poverty guidelines. The bill also requires the Oregon Health Authority to establish a workgroup to advise the agency on outreach and marketing strategies for this program.

The measure, the original staff measure summary, and the original fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).

The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Health Care on 2/21/17 and 3/7/17.

The -2 amendment changes the effective date for the changes to the program to January 1, 2018. An appropriation of \$36,113,214 General Fund is included.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -2 amendment.
