Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

**Analysis:**

The bill approves a \$1,000 fee for application by an Oregon career school for review and approval of any new programs proposed to be offered. The estimated revenue increase from this fee is projected to be \$32,000 Other Funds per biennium and will be used to support existing staff in the Private Career Schools Licensing Unit and agency operations associated with reviewing a newly proposed program for authorization.
