Re: SB 1041 Relating to treatment funded by public moneys

Senator Winters: “SB 1041 directs the Criminal Justice Commission to study, track, and account for all public moneys appropriated for and expended on alcohol and drug treatment and report on the results to the Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2019. As part of the study, the Commission is to examine the outcomes of each type of treatment and its effect on the criminal justice system.

The measure includes \$284,344 General Fund for a full-time limited duration policy analyst position to develop a system to track treatment funds and identify treatment outcomes. The position would continue for the first three months of the 2019-21 biennium until the report is finalized.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 1041 be amended by the –1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.”
