Subject: HB 3067 Relating to family supports
Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 3067 appropriates \$200,000 General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services for the 2017-19 biennium to distribute to Marion and Polk Counties to implement CourtCare pilot programs. The programs are designed to provide child care and serves as a clearinghouse for information and resource referrals for individuals and families with court-related business in or near a county courthouse. The measure requires the counties to report back on progress of the pilot programs by September 15, 2019.

The measure previously had a public hearing in the Public Safety Subcommittee on June 5th. According to public testimony provided at the hearing, the intent is to split the funds evenly between Marion and Polk counties.

There are no recommended changes to the measure.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that HB 3067 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
