Subject: HB 256 – Relating to Willamette Falls navigation infrastructure
Work Session Recommendations

SB 256 establishes a twenty-three member commission to advise state, local, and regional government agencies on the Willamette Falls Locks. Members of the commission are not entitled to compensation and may not be reimbursed for travel or other expenses.

Recommended Changes

Adoption of the -6 amendment is recommended, which appropriates \$190,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be distributed to Oregon Solutions at Portland State University. The amendment provides whereas language related to the history of the Willamette Falls, including whereas clauses for both the Columbia River tribes and the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon.
