**Measure Description:**

Provides Attorney General with increased enforcement authority over contraband cigarette sales in conjunction with nonparticipating manufacturer adjustment settlement related to Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement.

Prohibits person engaged in the business of selling cigarettes or smokeless tobacco products for profit from shipping or transporting such products to any person in this state other than a distributor or retailer. Requires face-to-face transactions for retail sale of tobacco products. Provides civil action enforcement authority to Attorney General.

**Revenue Impact:** Minimal

**Impact Explanation:**

The measure is expected to have a minimal impact upon tobacco excise tax revenues resulting from a potential modest positive impact on enforcement of cigarette and smokeless tobacco products.
