**Subject:** HB 3361 – Relating to open data standards  
Work Session Recommendations

This bill establishes the position of Chief Data Officer (CDO) appointed by the State Chief Information Officer to maintain a web portal for state agencies to release all publishable data. The measure specifies that the CDO is responsible for establishing an open data standard, publishing a technical standards manual, creating an inventory of publicly available state data and suggesting analytical opportunities.

The -A13 amendment requires state agencies to ensure that their use of proprietary software or creation of new databases do not impair the public's ability to inspect or copy records. The -A14 amendment provides a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative services for the Chief Data Officer position. LFO recommends the -A13 and -A14 amendments.

**Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A13 and -A14 amendments.
