**Subject:** SB 1039 – Relating to ocean chemistry

Work Session Recommendation

This bill establishes the Oregon Coordinating Council on Ocean Acidification and Hypoxia. The Coordinating Council will be staffed by the Department of Fish and Wildlife and will submit a biennial report with recommendations to the Legislative Assembly and the Ocean Policy Advisory Council by September 15 of each even-numbered year.

The fiscal impact statement and staff measure summary are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The -1 amendment provides a General Fund appropriation of \$162,286 to the Department for a position to staff the Coordinating Council. LFO recommends the -1 amendment.
