Subject: HB 2763 – Relating to school nursing services

The bill makes changes to the National Board Certification Fund and the types of costs which may be reimbursed from the fund. The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission is directed to waive the renewal fee for licenses of educators who are certified by a national professional organization for teaching standards.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A6 amendment which strikes langue related to funding from the Network of Quality Teaching and Learning, and instead provides a General Fund appropriation in the amount of \$1.7 million in the 2017-19 biennium. The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission may retain up to 10% of the moneys received in the fund for administrative expenses incurred related to teacher reimbursements.
