Subject: HB 2101 - Relating to public records Work Session Recommendation

This bill creates the Oregon Sunshine Committee to make recommendations to a new Legislative Counsel subcommittee regarding changes to public records laws. It also requires Legislative Counsel to prepare an open government impact statement for bills that affect disclosure of public records. Legislative Counsel has additional staff added to their budget to support these new activities and other open records efforts. The Department of Justice will require two additional FTE to support the work of the Oregon Sunshine Committee.

A staff measure summary and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The -A22 amendment adds a General Fund appropriation of $\$ 212,831$ for the additional staff at the Department of Justice.
