Re: HB 3391 Relating to reproductive health care

Representative Williamson: “HB 3391 requires health benefit plan coverage of specified health care services, drugs, devices, products and procedures related to reproductive health, all without cost sharing. It requires the Oregon Health Authority to implement a program to reimburse the costs of services related to reproductive health to individuals who would be eligible for medical assistance except for their immigration status. This program also includes medical coverage for these same individuals for 60 days after birth. Certain exemptions apply for plans sold to religious employers, as well as for abortion services if an insurer excludes that benefit in all it plans during the year.

The recommended amendment directs OHA to design a program to provide statewide access to abortion coverage for Oregon residents enrolled in health plans where abortion is excluded from coverage. The agency will report to the Legislature by November 1, 2017. An appropriation of \$10,195,935 General Fund is also included.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 3391 be amended by the –A10 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.”
