Subject: SB 100 Relating to residential energy conservation for oil-heated dwellings

Work Session Recommendations

Senate Bill 100 repeals the fuel oil dealer program and transfers the duties, functions and powers related to the State Home Oil Weatherization (SHOW) program from the Oregon Department of Energy to the Housing and Community Services Department. The SHOW program is funded through assessments of petroleum suppliers that is capped by statute at \$400,000 per year. Department of Energy anticipates transferring a balance of about \$657,000 from the assessment program on January 1, 2018 when the transfer is operative.

The Housing and Community Services Department anticipates the need for a full-time Program Analyst 1 position to develop the program in 2017-19. This position is then anticipated to decrease to half-time in 2019-21 after the program is established within Housing's administrative processes.

The -A3 amendment reduces the Other Funds expenditure limitation within the Department of Energy by \$568,250 to reflect the transfer of the program, and increases the Other Funds expenditure limitation within the Housing and Community Services Department by \$568,250 to reflect the program transfer and the administrative position.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment.
