Subject: SB 111 – Relating to school nursing services

The bill directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to aid school districts or education service districts with Medicaid billing for school nursing services. The bill has a \$529,935 General Fund and \$108,776 Federal Funds impact to ODE and the Oregon Health Authority in the 2017-19 biennium for three positions (2.67 FTE).

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A9 amendment which incorporates the changes made by the -A6 amendment and provides the necessary General Fund appropriations and Federal Funds expenditure limitation to ODE and OHA.
