Subject: HB 2038 – Relating to school food programs

The bill expands the types of organizations that may be considered for competitive grants to provide agriculture-based or garden-based educational activities to include education service districts, federally recognized Indian Tribes, schools overseen by the Bureau of Indian Education, or soil and water conservation districts.

The Legislative Fiscal Office notes that a \$2.5 million General Fund appropriation will be made for the Farm-to-School program in HB 5006 (2017).

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A12 amendment which incorporates the changes made by the -A11 amendment and removes the General Fund appropriation from the 2017-19 biennium.
