Subject: SB 1062 – Relating to environmental conditions in school facilities

The bill establishes the Healthy School Facilities Fund, and carves-out, beginning on or after July 1, 2019, \$2 million of State School Funds (SSF) from the existing facilities grant allocation to test and reduce exposure to elevated levels of lead in water, lead-based paint, and installing carbon monoxide detectors. The bill has a \$111,577 General Fund impact to the Department of Education (ODE) for 1 position (0.50 FTE) in the 2017-19 biennium

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment which appropriates \$111,577 General Fund to ODE in the 2017-19 biennium and includes a July 1, 2019 deadline for the adoption of the school districts plan required under Section 1 of the bill.
