Re: HB 2638 Relating to ignition interlock devices

Senator Monroe: “HB 2638 establishes a certification program for Ignition Interlock Device service centers and technicians that includes certification, inspection, criminal background checks for installers, and tracking and follow-up of negative IID reports. This program will be administered by the Department of Transportation in the 2017-19 biennium and then transferred to the Department of State Police on July 1, 2019.

The measure includes \$394,383 Other Funds expenditure limitation to ODOT for three full-time positions to administer the program. This program will be funded with federal National Highway Traffic Safety Administration grant funds until fees for the certification program are implemented and sufficient to cover State Police’s administrative costs.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends HB 2638 be amended by the –A7 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.”
