Subject: HB 3202: Work Session Recommendations

HB 3202-A establishes procedures and requirements for the establishment of criteria for land use decisions related to the Southwest Corridor MAX Light Rail Project. It gives the Supreme Court original jurisdiction for judicial review of criteria adopted by the Land Conservation and Development Commission, and judicial review of the Land Use Board of Appeals decision concerning a final order issued by the Metro council.

The bill has an estimated fiscal impact of \$205,157 Other Funds and 1 position for ODOT to issue development approvals, permits, licenses, and certificates for the construction of this project.
