Subject: HB 3149: Work Session Recommendations

HB 3149 makes several declarations regarding the Oregon Coast Trail system and requires the Oregon Department of Parks and Recreation to, in cooperation with the Oregon Department of Transportation and other entities, to develop an action plan to complete the trail. The measure further directs the Department of Parks and Recreation to identify and address several significant items to be considered in the plan.

The recommended A5 amendment removes those provisions in the A-engrossed version of the bill related to the creation of an Oregon Coast Trail fund and the requirement that the plan be completed and submitted to the legislature by September 15 2019, substituting instead that the Department must submit annual progress reports on the development and implementation of the plan.
